What does Double Degree Program mean?

- Thanks to specific agreements between UniInsubria and Partner Universities, GEEM students have the opportunity to get 2 degrees
- Participating students spend:
 - their first year studying at the University of Insubria
 - their second year (or part of it) studying at the Partner University
- Upon successful completion of the DDP, they get 2 diplomas:
 - Master's degree from the University of Insubria
 - Master's degree from the Partner University

Why attending the Double Degree Program?

- Letting apart the old say "Two is [usually] better than one", and other obvious reasons:
 - widening one's own horizons, great intercultural & social experience, etc.
- DDP gives students the opportunity to improve their knowledge of GEEM core subjects, i.e. innovation & applied economics, international business & management
- Enhances job opportunities, especially in international companies & organisations
- Not least, allows for improving one's knowledge of foreign languages

- Students attend 1 whole academic year at FSU-Jena
- Get at least 42 ECTS of exams at FSU-Jena

DD at Hohenheim

Universität Hohenheim



- Faculty of Business, Economics and Social Sciences
- Master of Science in International Business and Economics
- Focus on Internationalization
 - Combines latest knowledge in Innovation and International Economics, Management & International Business and Empirical Methods with an innovative and interdisciplinary teaching approach
- Students attend 1 whole academic year in Hohenheim
- Get at least 60 ECTS at Hohenheim University: 36 ECTS of exams,
 24 ECTS Master Thesis

DD at Bordeaux

- Master Intelligence économique, innovation et territoires, parcours Économie de l'innovation et veille stratégique (EVIS)

- Students attend 1 semester (4th semester) at Université de Bordeaux
- Get at least 30 ECTS at Université de Bordeaux: 12 ECTS of exams, 18 ECTS Master Thesis

DD at Fulda

Hochschule Fulda, University of Applied Sciences



- Department of Business
- Master of Science in International Management
- Focus on international business management
- Students attend 1 semester (3rd semester) at Hochschule Fulda
- Get at least 30 ECTS of exams at Hochschule Fulda

DD at Kaunas

Kaunas University of Technology



- School of Economics and Business
- Master of Science in International Business
- Focus on international business management
- Students attend 1 semester (3rd semester) at KTU
- Get at least 37 ECTS at KTU: 25 ECTS of exams and 12 ECTS of preliminary work to their master's thesis

 - UBx ⇒ having gained at least 66 ECTS (1st year) + 18 ECTS (1st semester 2nd yr.), of which 6 ECTS in seminar courses
 - Hochschule Fulda ⇒ having gained at least 54 ECTS, of which 6 ECTS in seminar courses
 - KTU ⇒ having gained at least 54 ECTS, of which 6 ECTS in seminar courses

Call for Applications opened on January 29 and closes on February 29 at 23:59

 - the Annex B Application Form
 - Carefully follow instructions given in these documents

Third step: send completed applications to dipartimento.economia@uninsubria.it, subject "APPLICATION TO THE DD CALL A.Y. 2024/2025", attaching:

- Application Form (Annex B)
- ② Curriculum vitae in EU format, specifying:
 - Complete contact information
 - Academic background
 - Bachelor mark
 - Job experiences, if any
 - Known languages
- 1st semester ToR, professors' written confirmation for yet unregistered exams
- Motivation letter
- Proof of English proficiency, if any
- Opy of personal ID Card or Passport

All documents must be **signed** and attached in **pdf format**

Selection criteria

The DD Committee will select candidates according to the following criteria:

- Academic performance
 - Marks' weighted average
 - Number of credits gained / total due credits
 - Bachelor degree final mark
- Knowledge of English
- Strong motivation
- Study plan coherence
- If needed, personal interviews with candidates will be organised
- The ranking list of successful candidates will be published on March 18, 4 p.m. on the DD Call for application website

Joining the DD Program

For what follows refer carefully to the Call for Application

- Participants to the DDP will be granted a scholarship of 650 euro/month
- As DD students, they must:
 - Renew their enrollment @UniInsubria
 - Formally accept their DD students status and scholarship
 - Follow all instructions given by the International Relations Office and prepare ALL needed documents in due time (see CfA)
 - Follow all instructions given by the Partner Universities (email; DD website)
 - Prepare their *Learning Agreement* (LA) and **get it signed by**:
 - **GEEM EI students** = prof. Carlo Brambilla
 - **GEEM IBE students** = prof. Alessia Pisoni
- A meeting with profs. Brambilla and Pisoni to prepare & sign LAs will be organised in the next weeks
