



Call for applications for the scholarship of a Extraordinary Grant - Academic Year 2026/2027

1. Definition

Extraordinary Grants consist of financial aid and are allocated within the limits of the specific budget allocation in favor of students who find themselves in a particular situation of hardship due to serious events that have affected them or their family unit. Such events must be properly documented.

For the purpose of awarding the contribution, the relevant events that must have occurred **between October 1, 2025, and September 30, 2026**, are:

- Students who find themselves in serious family economic difficulties, with the loss of their main source of income;
- Illnesses, accidents, surgeries, costly rehabilitative treatments that have severely affected the student or family members, compromising their school curriculum;
- Death of a family member.

Applicants must submit the documentation required for the scholarship grant, along with specific documentation related to the events for which the contribution is requested.

The absence of such documentation and the submission of non-compliant and/or incomplete documentation will result in exclusion from the call.

The allocation of the grant will be carried out by a designated committee.

The judging committee has the discretion to evaluate particular serious situations that occur after September 30, 2026.

2. Recipients

Students who are regularly enrolled and possess the income, merit, and academic regularity requirements established for the granting of scholarships and financial benefits for university study rights, funded by regional funds, are eligible to apply.

3. Amount of the Grant

Extraordinary Grants are awarded within the limits of the specific budget allocation, which for the academic year 2026/2027 is € 10.000,00.

Extraordinary Grants can be combined with all other forms of assistance and can be granted only once during each academic year and, for the same reason, only once for the entire duration of the academic career.

The amount of the grant cannot exceed € 1.000,00.

4. Application Submission

Applications for participation in the competition must be submitted **starting from 12:00 AM on July 24, 2026**, by filling out the appropriate online form available on the





website <https://www.uninsubria.it/formazione/opportunita-e-agevolazioni/diritto-allo-studio> under the section "Web Services for Right to Study." All requested documentation must be uploaded exclusively through the designated page of the online procedure.

The application must be submitted by October 30, 2026 — 3:00 PM.

5. Method of disbursement of the scholarship

The scholarships will be paid in a single installment after the merit rankings are published, presumably **by March 2027**.

6. Payment method

The scholarship will be paid via credit to the **University Card**, which must be activated for banking services.

7. Communication to beneficiaries

The results of the merit ranking will be available in the student's reserved area within the Web Services for Right to Study.

8. Tax treatment

The scholarships mentioned in this call do not benefit from tax advantages. They are subject to IRPEF tax withholdings in accordance with Article 50, paragraph 1, letter c) of DPR 917/86.

9. Information on the processing of personal data
