



NON-EU STUDENTS RESIDING ABROAD – A.A. 2019/2020

**INFORMATION REGARDING THE PROCEDURES, CRITERIA AND
CONTENT OF ITALIAN PROFICIENCY TEST AND ADMISSION TESTS
TO THE PLANNED ACCESS COURSES**

- **Italian Proficiency test:** the Italian Language test is required in order to ascertain the applicant's ability to a correct use of the written and spoken language. It consists in a dictation of a text in Italian about a non-specialist topic of medium grammatical and lexical difficulty; the applicants will be furthermore required to draw a short essay on the dictation topics and will be interviewed on their curriculum or on topics chosen by the Commission in relation to the chosen course of study. **The Italian Proficiency test will be held on the 2nd of September 2019 - 9:30 am (with call at 9.15 am) at the Classroom 1 mtg of the Department of Economics, Via Monte Generoso, 71 - Varese.**

Applicants must be present to the test with their passport with the specific visa for study purposes or, eventually, with a stay permit or the receipt of the stay permit application issued by the Post Office.

- **Test for the admission to the Bachelor Degrees in health and medical professions:** The test consists in the solution of 60 multiple choice questions of which only one, among the five listed, is correct. the topics of the test are the following: General Culture (12 questions), Logical Reasoning (10 questions), biology (18 questions), Chemistry (12 questions), Physics and Mathematics (8 questions). The syllabus for each subject is attached to the Ministerial Decree 28/03/2019 - Appendix A and available at www.miur.it. Candidates are given 100 minutes to solve the questions. **The test is held at the Department of Economics in Via Monte Generoso 71 in Varese, on the 11th of September 2019 at 9:00 am.** If necessary and on the base of the number of the candidates, a further seat will be available: the Pavilion Morselli - Via O. Rossi - Varese. Candidates will be distributed in different classrooms based on their age. Applicants must be present to the test with their passport with the specific visa for study purposes (without these documents candidates will be excluded from the test) as well as the receipt of the payment of the sum of € 20.00 made by bank transfer no later than the 20 of August 2019, or by using the electronic





notice of payment form no later than the 20 of August 2019, as a contribution for the participation in the admission test. Starting from the 30th of August 2019, each candidate may view the classroom of destination on the University website (www.uninsubria.it), on the Students Affairs web services webpage. For anything not listed please refer to the specific Competition Rules available at www.uninsubria.it/concorsi.

- **Test for the admission to the Master Degree in Medicine and Surgery:**
The test consists in the solution of 60 multiple choice questions of which only one, among the five listed, is correct. The topics of the test are the following: General Culture (12 questions), Logical Reasoning (10 questions), Biology (18 questions), Chemistry (12 questions), Physics and Mathematics (8 questions). The syllabus for each subject is attached to the Ministerial Decree of 28/03/2019 n. 277 and available at www.miur.it and on the University website. Candidates are given 100 minutes to solve the questions. **The test is held at the Department of Economics in Via Monte Generoso, 71 in Varese, on the 3rd of September 2019 at 9:00 am.** Candidates will be distributed in different classrooms based on their age. Starting from the 21 of August 2019, each candidate may view the classroom of destination on the on-line services of the students affairs webpage www.uninsubria.it – Servizi Web Segreteria Studenti). For anything not listed please refer to the specific Competition Rules available at www.uninsubria.it/concorsi. Applicants must be present to the test with their passport with the specific visa for study purposes (without these documents candidates will be excluded from the test) as well as the receipt of the payment of the sum of € 20.00 made by using electronic notice of payment or by bank transfer using the following data:
