The distinguished lecture by Professor Grazia Mannozzi from the Law, Economic and Culture department of the University of Insubria, Como, Italy

Grazia Mannozzi is professor of "Criminal Law" and of "Restorative Justice and Victim-offender Mediation" at the University of Insubria (Como - Italy), where she is also the Director of the Restorative Justice and Mediation Study Centre (CeSGReM) and of the Master in Restorative Justice and Humanistic Mediation. For the year 2019 she is Chair of Working Group on Restorative Cities established at the European

Forum for Restorative Justice. In 2013 and 2017 she was member of two different Italian Legislative Commissions, the first one to reform the sanction system, the second one to reform the enforcement of punishment.

In her research activity, she has mainly focused on sentencing system, restorative justice, economic crimes, corruption, corporate liability, law and language. Her publications have been translated in several languages. In 2017, she published the first Italian handbook of restorative justice, titled "La giustizia riparativa. Formanti, parole e metodi", Giappichelli, Torino (with G. A. Lodigiani).
